I want to thank **Jeff Bradbury** for his presentation on Saison last month. We had a diverse bunch of homebrewed Saisons on tap and it was yet another great meeting. The BJCP style has a wide definition because they can very different from farmhouse brewery to farmhouse brewery in Wallonia. I personally like the super dry varieties that are not spiced. The yeast character alone can give a great spiciness if fermented correctly. I use a mix of Belgian Pilsner and Vienna malts to get that yellow-orange hue. While Saison Dupont may be the standard bearer, there are many ways to make a great Saison.

It's August, already. I hope everyone is enjoying their summer and getting time to brew. Son of Brewzilla is not too far away. Registration is open and will close by September 15th. Greg Irving, Brian Wright and I have been working pretty hard to organize this year's competition. We're not only looking for you to brew up entries. We're minimizing the hours of the party from 6:00 to 9:00 so that those of us that will be working the competition the next day can get an early night. **Matt Cole** is looking forward to hosting us, so let's not disappoint him. Not only will be September 15th be the deadline for Son of Brewzilla entries, it will also be the Saturday evening dinner at SNOB Octobeerfest. If you just come for dinner, bring a side dish to share and some beer to share. There will be plenty of jockey boxes of homebrew, but we can never have enough variety. I do ask that you bring along a designated driver or be very mindful of your intake if you plan to just spend the evening with us. We'll talk a little during the meeting and start to get a headcount. As all campouts, the club will purchase the main dish and you should bring a side t share for each evening meal. Tim McDonnell and John Majetic always do a fantastic job procuring, preparing and smoking the meat we buy for our campouts.

When I was in San Diego last year for the National Homebrewers Conference, I had the pleasure to hear both Firestone Walker Brewmaster **Matt Brynildson** and Anheuser-Busch Endowed Professor of Brewing Science **Dr. Charles Bamforth** speak about hops. Matt's talk focused primarily on hop oils and late hopping techniques to the BJCP members. Charlie's NHC seminar was more on the goodness that are hops and what they provide to beer. If you are an American Homebrewers Association member, you may have seen Stone Brewmaster **Mitch Steele's** article on hops.

What I am going to attempt to do this month is put together a presentation of what I've been able to learn about hops and hopefully I'll only bore some of you. Did you know that alpha acid isomerization happens at 185° F and above? That means that in the whirlpool after knockout, you're still adding IBUs to the beer. I have gotten in the habit of pushing my flavor addition to 10 minutes and my aroma addition after I turn off the flame and start chilling. At least that's what I do with my hoppy Americanstyle beers. If you have some of the Big Brew Brown IPA or you have your own hoppy creation, please bring it in and I'll lead a discussion on all things hoppy.

Our September meeting will be Monday, August 27th. We've been holding our September meetings on the last Monday of August because we have a busy September.

This year, we will not be asked to help pour at the Cleveland Octoberfest. This is nothing to reflect badly on our club. Last year there were a couple of incidents. I don't even think they happened on Friday evening. The organizers have decided to only use people with TIPS Training to spot those that have had too many. We should still be making a demo brew on Labor Day Sunday at the Berea Fairgrounds. We'll talk about getting a team together to brew something and talk SNOB on the Midway. We still have SNOB Octobeerfest and Son of Brewzilla, so there is plenty to do in September. Having the meeting after Labor Day would be rough for last minute organization of our club events.

Hope to see everyone at our August meeting(s). Get brewing for Son of Brewzilla!
