Also, don't forget to pay your dues!




### PRESIDENT'S KRAUSENING

The cost for the bus will be \$92 per person, payable to the SNOBs. You will also be responsible for booking and paying for your own hotel room. The hotel is TBD, but the cost should be around \$90. You can BYO roommate, or if you are seeking one let us know when you sign up and we will try and pair you up.

### **BULK PBW AND STAR SAN BUY**

We're looking to make a bulk buy of some often used brewery cleaners of Five Star PBW and Star San. Depending on how many people sign up, the cost will represent a 50-75% savings.

PBW will be \$3.75 per pound or less and Star San will be \$.62 per ounce or less (and likely under \$.50). Star San will likely be capped at 5 gallons unless there is enough interest to get 10 gallons. We hope to have firm prices in a few days.


