We’ll have a brief presentation about preparing a brewing calendar and an open discussion about why we brew when we do.

**We’re going to try something new with our raffle.** There will be more details at the meeting, but here’s a brief description of how we hope it will work. Ticket sales will start at the beginning of the meeting as usual, but will close a bit earlier. Then, our “raffle team” will quietly conduct the drawing and match winning tickets to prizes as the meeting continues. Toward the end of the meeting we’ll post a list of winning ticket numbers, and winners can pick up their prizes as the meeting wraps up or on their way out. Our hope is to have the raffle completed earlier in the evening so that more members can participate without having to stay quite so late, and to provide more time for socializing without it conflicting with the meeting or raffle.

Notice that there is both a donation in Income and Expenses this quarter. A big thanks goes out to Shannon Huttinger for volunteering to do a small beer tasting for a private event and then get a monetary contribution for the club. We also closed the books on the Son of Brewzilla homebrew competition with a net profit of \$1,888. Nice job to all that took part in this event. We have therefore made a \$750 donation towards the "Memorial Fund for Grace & Lucy [Rothgery]." These two, young girls lost their parents a few years back and are being raised by family members locally. Their Mom (Molly) worked for GLBC. Here is the email I got from their aunt after making the deposit to their account:

"We are very appreciative of the generous donation the SNOBs have made. We have continued to use the funds in the account for specialized services for the girls to help them deal with the loss of their mother. I live near them, and my husband and I see them frequently. They are both doing well. They saw a note about the SNOBs that I had made to myself, and they asked about it. We explained that you are a wonderful group of brewers who contribute to a fund that we can use to help them with expenses that might be beyond our capacity to fund (counseling, orthodontia, and educational expenses). They think it's pretty cool that people care.

We have been going to a wonderful place called Cornerstone for Hope, which is in Independence. They have specialized grief services, including groups for those who have lost loved ones to murder or suicide. They have some amazing counselors and help kids feel safe in dealing with their pain. I learned from attending services there myself that some people go through this experience of a traumatic loss with little community support. It means a lot to us that your organization, and the individuals in it, continue to honor Molly's memory by helping her children.
