I look forward to standing behind the SNOB bar that Mark designed and built while we're at the 2016 National Homebrew Conference in Baltimore this June.

In March, the No Sweat Bus Trip will travel to Buffalo (March 12th – 13th). Upcoming competitions include: the Cincinnati Malt Infusers "All American Home Brew Competition" (February 13th), "The British Beerfest Competition" in Columbus (February 20th), "The Wizard of Saaz" in Akron (March 18th), and the "AHA National Homebrew Competition" (first round begins on March 13th) which is unfortunately the same weekend as our bus trip to Buffalo. Please consider entering your homebrews into these competitions even if you aren't available to volunteer as a judge or steward. Most competitions donate a portion of the entry fees to charity and offer valuable feedback from experienced judges. No matter if you have only brewed a few batches or have been brewing at home since before it was legal, I encourage you to participate in competitions near and far. Please don't forget to list "Society of Northeast Ohio Brewers (SNOB)" as your club when you register your entries.
