# NHC First Round Comes to Cleveland



### 🏁 WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

This year, we are proud and excited to announce that the Society of Northeast Ohio Brewers (SNOB) and Society of Akron Area Zymurgists will be hosting a First Round location for the National Homebrew Competition at <u>Fat Heads Brewery & Beer</u> <u>Hall</u> in <u>Middleburg Heights</u>, Ohio. Here is what you need to know.

#### Volunteering:

We highly encourage as many members as possible to volunteer. If you are not already an AHA member, we encourage you to become one at <u>homebrewersassociation.org</u>. Volunteer registration opens on February 5, and you will have to register through BrewingCompetition.com. Volunteers get entry location preference for next year's conference. Volunteers will be needed on March 24 for unboxing, and March 29-31 for the competition itself. Please note, if you are bringing entries you MAY NOT bring them on the day of unboxing.

#### Entering:

You must be an AHA member to enter. The NHC competition differs from our usual competitions in several other ways. First, please note that even though we are hosting a first round in Cleveland, you are not guaranteed your first choice of locations or, in fact, get any entries at all. Entries are assigned both in number and location by a lottery system. Secondly, this is not a competition to enter for feedback. You will not receive a detailed score sheet and entries are \$16 each, so you should only submit entries that you have had success with. Finally, make sure you plan ahead. For the first round you will need to submit 2 12 oz. bottles. If you make it to the final round you will have to submit another 3. Because the two competitions are 3 months apart, this may require a re-brew to ensure that you are entering a product of the same quality.

There are several other competitions coming soon, those will be detailed on page 4. You can enter these competitions for feedback, and will provide you helpful information.

**IMPORTANT NHC DATES** 

- Now till January 21: Sign up or renew AHA membership. You cannot compete without AHA membership. It is encouraged to be an AHA member to volunteer.
- January 22 to 29: National Homebrew Competition Open Enrollment: You are requesting entries in NHC and you may not get Cleveland as your first choice for the location where you will be sending your entries. It had been the max of 4 entries per entrant the last couple of years. Plan to enter your best. This is not a competition to enter for feedback.
- **February 1 14**: Beer Registration & Payments: You will be assigned an NHC First Round location and a number of entries. Pay for your entries by February 14th. You may edit your entries through the shipping window.
- **February 5th**: Volunteer Registration opens. You have to register through the BrewingCompetition.com website on February 5th or after to volunteer. You will get entry location preference if you volunteered the previous year.
- March 1 14: First Round Shipping Window: Your entries have to get to the shipping or drop-off location between March 1st and March 14th. There are no exceptions. You cannot bring entries to Unboxing Day.
- March 24th: Cleveland Unboxing Day at Fat Heads Middleburg Heights
- March 29 31: NHC First Round Cleveland at Fat Heads Middleburg Heights
- April 12-14: NHC First Round Indianapolis
- April 26th: All First Round Results will be posted. You will be able to see your scores and the category medalists for each First Round location by this date.
- May 3rd: First Round Scoresheets are emailed.

Medalists that scored 30 points or higher will have the opportunity to ship their entries to Providence, RI for the 2019 Second Round, that will happen during HomebrewCon.

- June 10 20: Final Round Shipping Window
- June 27: Final Round Judging
- June 29: Final Round Awards Ceremony. The Brewing Network will broadcast the ceremony if you are not attending HomebrewCon.


And all of that is not to mention the fantastic beer, great food, and spacious location. It's sure to be a fun time.
