Big Brew took place May 10 at the Fathead's Production Brewery again this year, thank you to Matt. Chris and the entire Fathead's crew for being such great supporters of the SNOB. We must have had 30 SNOBs on hand for the brew day which really made the job easier, John's gigantic system requires a lot of cleaning and all those hands made it go quickly. And another huge thanks to Fatheads for donating the 305# grain bill and yeast and Mark Sheppa for donating the 4# of hops. At the end of the brew day we were treated to some smoked wings that Matt smoked up on his brand new smoker, delicious! After two weeks of fermenting, we decided that we really needed to check and more than likely transfer the stout. Turns out it was good timing as there was still some yeast activity on top and a protective layer of CO<sub>2</sub>. Being a holiday, only Tim and I made it over and 4 hours later and our share of problems, its in the barrel. The final gravity of the beer ended up at 1.016 and an ABV of 9.7%, barrel aging started on May 26.



SNOB Night Out in May (read that SNOB Sunday Brunch) at Sterles Country House was very well attended with 30 or so of us there. It was a beautiful day for a Sunday brunch on the patio at Sterles and was like a family gathering. Great job mixing it up Nate.
