PRESIDENT'S KRAUSENING

This June should be a pretty event filled month. Starting with our meeting on 6/3, where Todd will be bringing in some unaltered cider, and sharing some of his best practices on how to balance a cider once the cider has finished fermentation. Members will be able to make adjustments to try their hand out at balancing, and can compare the results. In addition, Jim and Cara will be bringing in an experiment that they'd like some help with. They brewed some wort, with the exact same hop additions, but used different yeast strains to ferment 6 separate batches. The beers will be on tap, and they will be looking for feedback as to the differences perceived between each one. At the next meeting Jim and Cara will return with our feedback, and the lessons learned from the experiment.

The weekend after the meeting, on 6/8, we will do our Big Brew day at Terrestrial Brewing Company. Please stop by to watch the brewing process, and sign up for taking wort to alter/ferment for the competition to be held at the August Meeting. The wort will be a pale ale base, without any hops added, so that it can be manipulated however you'd like.

Lastly, if you are available please volunteer for the Cleveland Summer Beerfest, and ensure that you add TRINITY in the non profit space. Doing so will provide the Trinity Clothing Ministry \$25.

BIG BREW 2019

The SNOBs Big Brew 2019 will be on June 8.

Here's how it will work.

On June 8, we will create the wort at Terrestrial Brewing Company. The malt bill will be similar to last year, close to a pale ale. The wort will be unhopped, and boiled briefly for sanitation. SNOBs members are encouraged to brew with us!

<u>Click here to sign up for wort</u>. Each person will get 5 gallons (or more, if you want), and it's first-come, first-served (paid members only). Participants can take this wort home and treat it however they would like. Specialty grains, hops, fruits, spices, etc... just let your imagination go wild! In August there will be a contest at Terrestrial for the best beer. The winner will get a chance to brew their recipe with Terrestrial. In addition, we will have a people's choice competition at the August meeting.
