The recipe has been set, an Imperial Stout that will be aged in an oak Makers Mark barrel that SNOB Jason Shultz sold to the club. It will be a fun filled day, hope to see you there. Here is the recipe we will be using with possibility of some minor tweaking

205lb 2 Row

17.5lb Flaked barley

17.5lb Roasted barley

15lb Chocolate Malt

10lb Cara Munich III

25lb Muscovado sugar

30oz Magnum hops @ 60 min

95 gallon batch, 265lb Total Grain, OG 1.089,

IBU 80, ABV 8.4%
