Thank you to Ralph and his team for helping us with Big Brew again this year! Here's how it works!

- 1) Five gallons per person (we will give more only if there is enough, bring a container in case)
- 2) Between April 25 and March 1 (cut off time TBD) bring a clean, sanitized container to Terrestrial (7524 Father Frascati, Cleveland, OH 44102). Container should be labeled with your name. Consider saying thank you by picking up a pint or taking home a crowler.
- 3) Members will NOT be participating in the brewing process, but on Brew day (May 1) your container will be rinsed with start san and filled with unhopped wort. Exact specs TBD, but in the past it has been something close to a pale ale. Pick up time TBD based on how the brew day is going. Pick up another pint while you are there!
- 4) Bring your wort home and make something great (consider a holiday ale! See below!)

This will replace our July meeting and will feature the Big Brew competition.
