- Beer 1: Dry-hopped Cream Ale fermented with Bootleg Biology Oslo Kveik strain
- Beer 2: Robust Porter fermented with Omega Lutra Kveik strain
- Beer 3: Pale Ale fermented with Imperial Kveiking 3-strain

Interested members can receive a set of each of these beers to taste along with us. They will also receive one of the three yeast strains used.

Of course, this year it will look a little different with social distancing guidelines in place. We will have more details soon about the bottle share, food, and more.


